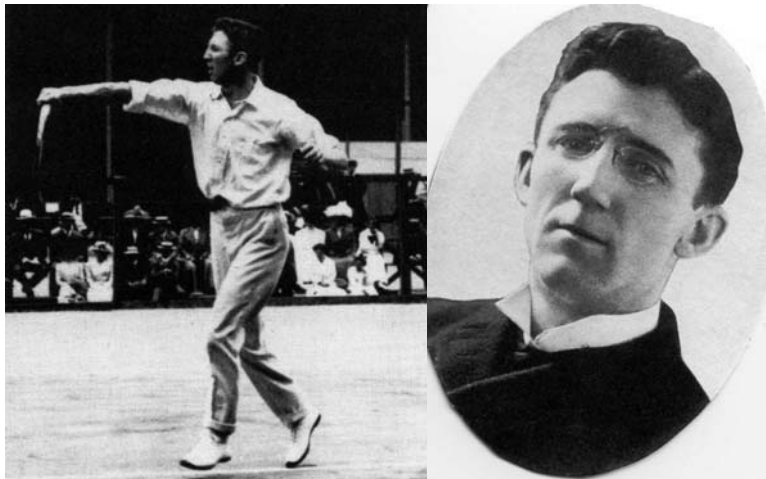
THE CLUB
