Irvington Club Waiting List Procedures

To ensure Club members quality court usage, The Irvington Club Board of Trustees instituted a membership cap in 1990. The current cap is 320 total Family, Couple, and Single memberships. This number may be changed at the Board's discretion.

A non-refundable fee of \$500 is charged to be placed on The Irvington Club waiting list. This fee is applied toward the eventual Club membership initiation. Initiation fees are fixed at the time an applicant is placed on the waiting list. However, if an applicant declines membership when their name comes up, they will be required to pay the current initiation fee.

When an applicant becomes eligible for membership, they may decline and be moved 25 spaces down on the waiting list. If they decline a second time they will be placed at the bottom of the waiting list. Declining a third time will result in being dropped from the waiting list.

The top 25 on the waiting list will be invited to become Associate Members. There is a monthly fee associated with the program and it allows applicant's partial access to the Club as outlined in the next section.

Associate Member Privileges

1. Eight (8) Day of Play reservations per month for use of the tennis courts (after 6:00 pm the night before). Cannot play on Day Previous reservations.
2. Participation on USTA Teams.
3. Play in all Club tournaments.
4. Unlimited participation in Men's/Women's open play.
5. Access to clinics and private lessons at member costs.
6. Unlimited use of the weight room and spa.
7. Ten (10) visits to the pool per summer season.
8. A copy of the membership roster which includes tennis rules and regulations.
9. May play with members on Day Previous reservation as a guest according to regular guest policy (guest fee plus a maximum of twice a month).

Irvington Club Facilities

TENNIS

The Irvington Club features four indoor courts with plexipave surface and excellent lighting. There is both a doubles and a singles court outside. Court reservations are one hour and fifteen minutes. The first reservation time each day is 7:00am and the last is 8:45pm.

Other activities include: Tournaments (USTA sanctioned and club), mixers, league competition, and a junior program.

LESSONS

Two certified USPTA Tennis Professionals are available for group and private lessons. A junior development program is offered year round.

PRO SHOP

Quality top-brand tennis racquets and accessories are available as well as racquet stringing.

SWIMMING

The outdoor pool, with a snack bar, spa, and shower facilities is open from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Group and private lessons are available, as well lap swimming and junior swim teams. A lifeguard is on duty during operating hours. Separate pool memberships are available for the summer season.

FITNESS

An exercise room features cardio machines, free weights, and universal equipment. A strength and conditioning specialist and a personal trainer are available for your fitness needs. A co-ed spa and sauna are available for member use.

BALLROOM

The ballroom and kitchen facility may be rented for parties and special events. For more information call 503-287-8749.

ANNUAL PARTY & ANNUAL BARBECUE

The Club hosts an Annual Party in the winter and an Annual Barbecue in the summer for its members.

Irvington Club History

- The Irvington Club was founded in 1898 on donated land between Tillamook and Hancock Streets and Northeast 19th and 21st Avenues in Portland, Oregon. The Club started with only two clay courts.

- In 1905 six courts and a one-story clubhouse were constructed, and in 1912 a two-story structure was added at the east end of the clubhouse.

- In 1946 the clay courts were converted to asphalt with a plexipave surface.

- An outdoor swimming pool was added in 1957.

- In 1965, a new clubhouse was completed and two courts were covered. Four years later, two more courts were covered bringing the total to four indoor and one outdoor.

- The Irvington Club was the original home for several important tournaments including the Pacific Northwest Senior Indoor, The Rose Festival, Pacific Coast Indoor Invitational, and the Oregon State Tournament (first sponsored in 1899). Many outstanding Northwest champions have made their "names" at The Irvington Club.

Irvington Club Traditions

The Irvington Club is a unique non-profit organization because it is member-owned. A board of nine trustees is elected by the membership and each trustee serves a three-year term. The Board elects the officers and meets monthly for the purpose of managing club affairs.

The Board of Trustees, Club Manager Barbara Farmer, Tennis Director Adam Gagnon, and Head Pro Cris Valverde work closely with the membership to respond to club needs.

Members, and the City of Portland alike, can be proud that The Irvington Club is one of the oldest tennis clubs in the country, and that it has made a great contribution to the community and to the game of tennis.
