

## USTA League Sign-ups FAQ's

**Q: I don't see my rating? Why not?**

A: If you do not see your rating, it either means your rating has expired because you have not played for a while or you have never been rated. Go to <http://tennislink.usta.com/leagues> and click on the "About Self-Rate" tab on the right side of the page. This will guide you through the process of rating yourself.

**Q: I see people I don't recognize on the list. Are they members?**

A: Everyone listed has been on an Irvington Club league team at some point in the past. It does not necessarily mean they will be on a team this year. The USTA does not distinguish Irvington Member vs. Irvington Non-Member.

**Q: I really want to play up. What do I do?**

A: Sign-up on the sheet that says "Interested in Playing Up." This means you are on the list for consideration. The captain of each team will determine if they need players to play up. If so, you will be contacted by Walter. Please keep in mind that signing up on the list "to play up" by no means guarantees you are able to play up.

**Q: Can I play on multiple teams at the same level?**

A: No. You can only play on one team per level, per district (i.e. Northern Oregon).

**Q: A captain has already contacted me. Do I need to sign-up?**

A: You should still sign-up just to be 100% sure Walter knows you are on a team.

**Q: I don't like my rating. How do I appeal?**

**A: See explanation of ratings and appeal information posted on the bulletin board.**

**Q: When is the deadline to get on a team?**

**A: All Irvington members MUST sign-up for a team by January 12, 2010. Shortly after, all rosters will be approved by Walter and posted on the bulletin board. Also, keep in mind that no roster is set in stone until it is approved by Walter in January.**

**Q: Who are the captains?**

**A: See the captains list posted on the bulletin board.**

**Q: No one asked me to be a captain. Can I be a captain?**

**A: There was a captain interest sheet posted on the bulletin board in mid-October. Next season, check you newsletter and e-mails for when the captain interest sheet goes up again and you can sign-up if you are interested.**
